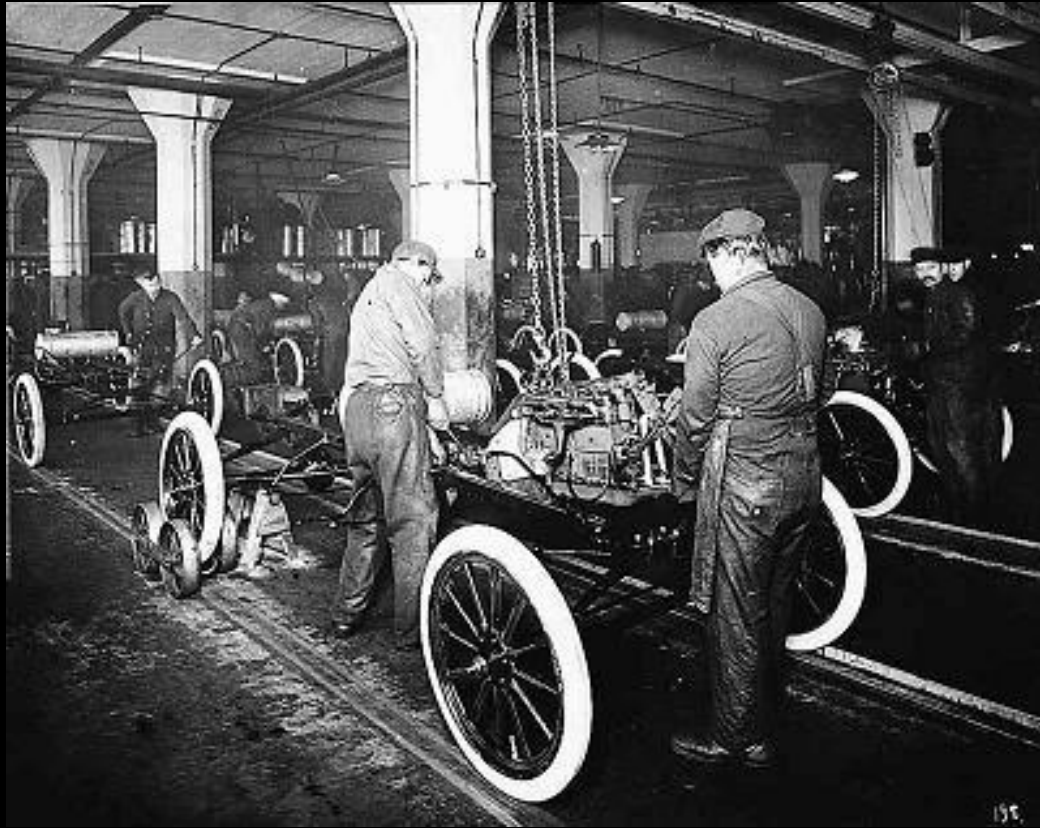

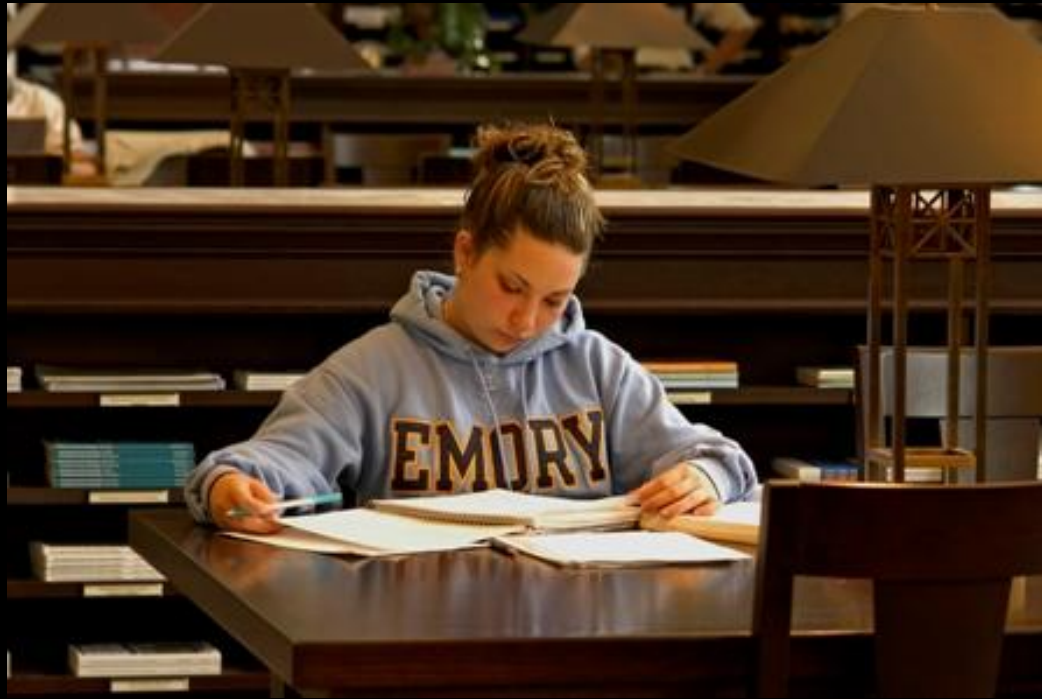

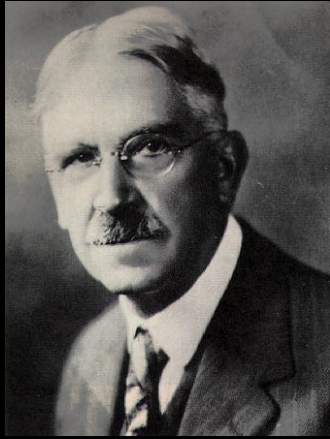
Human Ecology

... is a holistic approach to help people solve problems and enhance human potential within their near environments -- their clothing, family, home, and community.

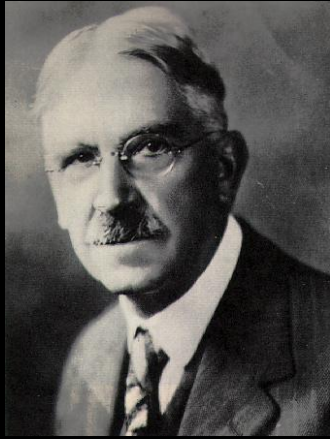
